



Mulberry Chapter Hexie MugRug (or Coaster)

Hexie MugRug/Coaster Tutorial

For MugRug, you can use 10" Squares **OR** if you are using yardage, cut an 8.5" strip, fold it in fourths to get 8.5" x 10.5".

Sub-cut into hexies. You'll get 4 Hexies per strip.

You need 8 hexies total. 1-bottom, 1 inside (*won't be seen*), 6 for the top.
Iron the six hexies in half, making a half moon type shape.

making coasters use 5" squares, but same process).

Supplies:

(8) 10" Squares for mug rug
Sewing machine and iron

Assembly:

Stack two hexies **wrong sides together**, with the one you want to be the back of the coaster on top.

Then you need to press 6 of the hexies in half, **wrong** sides together.

Learn this mantra:

Lay down Hex #1 thru #4, lay #5 pick up one, lay #6, pick up two

If you are going to add a hangar loop, insert that now, with hook to the inside, line up raw edges with raw edges of hexies.

Sew a quarter inch around outer edge through ALL layers. Clip bulk.

Turn right side out, iron, and top stitch outer edge
